## THE NATURE OF STEALING—WHAT IT IS

Definition: taking something that does not belong to you without permission.

## THE GRAVITY OF STEALING—WHY IT'S WRONG

- Stealing dishonors God's \_\_\_\_\_ Psalm 24:1 The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it.

## TURNING FROM STEALING—HOW TO APPLY

Ephesians 4:28 He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have something to share with one who has need.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Proverbs 3:9-10 Honor the Lord from your wealth and from the first of all your produce; so your barns will be filled with plenty and your vats will overflow with new wine.

20:16 You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

## THE NATURE OF LYING—WHAT IT IS

Definition: To give false testimony, speak deceitfully, state untruths that damage another's reputation, and to shun gossip, slander, and flattery.

20:17 You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

Definition: an unwarranted, ungoverned, selfish desire for something.
