Day of Atonement 16:15, 21 Then [Aaron] shall slaughter the goat of the sin offering which is for the people, and bring its blood inside the veil and do with its blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and in front of the mercy seat...²¹ Then Aaron shall lay both of his hands on the head of the live goat, and confess over it all the iniquities of the sons of Israel and all their transgressions in regard to all their sins; and he shall lay them on the head of the goat and send it away into the wilderness by the hand of a man who stands in readiness.

17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.

Then the cloud settled down in the wilderness of Paran.

Obedience required 10:12-13 Now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require from you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and love Him, and to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul,
¹³ and to keep the Lord’s commandments and His statutes which I am commanding you today for your good?

Blessing promised 28:1-2 Now it shall be, if you diligently obey the Lord your God, being careful to do all His commandments which I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.

² All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you obey the Lord your God.

Moses Died 34:5 So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord.
