Hebrews 11:1 Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

Hebrew 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please Him.

Numbers 12:3 Now the man Moses was very humble, more than any man who was on the face of the earth.

1. Faith _____ God v23

v23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's edict.

Exodus 1:17 But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt had commanded them, but let the boys live.

Exodus 2:2 The woman conceived and bore a son; and when she saw that he was beautiful, she hid him for three months.

Acts 7:20 It was at this time that Moses was born; and he was lovely in the sight of God, and he was nurtured three months in his father's home.

Acts 7:23-25 But when he was approaching the age of forty, it entered his mind to visit his brethren, the sons of Israel.

²⁴ And when he saw one of them being treated unjustly, he defended him and took vengeance for the oppressed by striking down the Egyptian. ²⁵ And he supposed that his brethren understood that God was granting them deliverance through him, but they did not understand.

2. Faith _____ God v24-26

- Your _____ v24-25a (boastful pride of life)

v24-25a By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ²⁵ choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God....

- Your _____ v25b (lust of the flesh)

v25b than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin...

2 Peter 2:19 by what a man is overcome, by this he is enslaved.

- Your _____ v26 (lust of the eyes)

v26 considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, ¹⁸ while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Psalms 73:25-26 Whom have I in heaven but You? And besides You, I desire nothing on earth. ²⁶ My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Philippians 3:7-8 But whatever things were gain to me, those things I have counted as loss for the sake of Christ. ⁸ More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ.

1 John 2:15-17 Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, **the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life**, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

3. Faith _____ God v27

v27 By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured, as seeing Him who is unseen.

Exodus 10:28-29 Then Pharaoh said to him, “Get away from me! Beware, do not see my face again, for in the day you see my face you shall die!” ²⁹ Moses said, “You are right; I shall never see your face again!”

Exodus 14:5 When the king of Egypt was told that the people had fled, Pharaoh and his servants had a change of heart toward the people, and they said, “What is this we have done, that we have let Israel go from serving us?”

Psalms 16:8 I have set the Lord continually before me; because He is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

4. Faith _____ God v28

v28 By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of the blood, so that he who destroyed the firstborn would not touch them.

Exodus 12:13 The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

Exodus 12:28 Then the sons of Israel went and did so; just as the Lord had commanded Moses and Aaron, so they did.

5. Faith _____ God v29

v29 By faith they passed through the Red Sea as though they were passing through dry land; and the Egyptians, when they attempted it, were drowned.

Exodus 14:13-15 But Moses said to the people, “Do not fear! Stand by and see the salvation of the Lord which He will accomplish for you today; for the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you will never see them again forever. ¹⁴ “The Lord will fight for you while you keep silent.” ¹⁵ Then the Lord said to Moses, “Why are you crying out to Me? Tell the sons of Israel to go forward.

Exodus 14:22 The sons of Israel went through the midst of the sea on the dry land, and the waters were like a wall to them on their right hand and on their left.

Exodus 14:27-28 Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to its normal state at daybreak, while the Egyptians were fleeing right into it; then the Lord overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea. ²⁸ The waters returned and covered the chariots and the horsemen, even Pharaoh’s entire army that had gone into the sea after them; not even one of them remained.
