Genesis 46:2-4 God spoke to Israel in visions of the night and said, "Jacob, Jacob." And he said, "Here I am." ³ He said, "I am God, the God of your father; do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for I will make you a great nation there. ⁴ "I will go down with you to Egypt, and I will also surely bring you up again; and Joseph will close your eyes."

Genesis 22: 17-18 indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies. ¹⁸ "In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

Hebrews 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's edict.

Acts 7:21-23 Pharaoh's daughter took him away and nurtured him as her own son. ²² "Moses was educated in all the learning of the Egyptians, and he was a man of power in words and deeds. ²³ "But when he was approaching the age of forty, it entered his mind to visit his brethren, the sons of Israel.

Hebrews 11:24-27 By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ²⁵ choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, ²⁶ considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward.

Exodus 2:22 Then she gave birth to a son, and he named him Gershom, for he said, "I have been a sojourner in a foreign land."

4. God answers in His _____ 2:23-25

Exodus 7:7 Aaron was eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three, when they spoke to Pharaoh.

Exodus 6:5 Furthermore I have heard the groaning of the sons of Israel, because the Egyptians are holding them in bondage, and I have remembered My covenant.

Genesis 15:13-14 God said to Abram, "Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be enslaved and oppressed four hundred years. ¹⁴ "But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.
