TRIALS PRODUCE:

IRUST 2 Corinthians 1:9 Indeed, we had the sentence of death within ourselves so that we would not trust in ourselves, but in God who raises the dead.

HOLINESS Hebrews 12:10-11 But He disciplines us for our good, so that we may share His holiness. All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.
