1. God is a promise _____ v1-3a

Genesis 17:7-8 I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your descendants after you. ⁸ I will give to you and to your descendants after you, the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

Hebrews 6:13 For when God made a promise to Abraham, since He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, 'Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you.'

Exodus 23:20 Behold, I am going to send an angel before you to guard you along the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared.

Exodus 15:24 So the people grumbled at Moses, saying, "What shall we drink?"

Exodus 16:2 The whole congregation of the sons of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness.

Exodus 17:2,3 Therefore the people quarreled with Moses... and they grumbled against Moses.

Exodus 32:7 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, "Go down at once, for your people, whom you brought up from the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves.

Exodus 32:35 Then the Lord smote the people, because of what they did with the calf which Aaron had made.

Exodus 3:6 He said also, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." Then Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.

Judges 13:22 So Manoah said to his wife, "We will surely die, for we have seen God."

Genesis 32:30 Jacob named the place Peniel, for he said "I have seen God face to face, yet my life has been preserved." **Isaiah 6:2** Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.
