How do you handle preferences?

1. Being Right Doesn't Mean You're _____ Others (v.1-7)

Romans 14:2–4 » One person has faith that he may eat all things, but he who is weak eats vegetables *only*.³ The one who eats is not to regard with contempt the one who does not eat, and the one who does not eat is not to judge the one who eats, for God has accepted him.⁴ Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls; and he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

2. _____ are Often Not What We Assume (v.7-8)

Romans 14:13 » Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather determine this—not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way.

3. Your Love for Others Should _____ your Freedoms (v.9-13)

Romans 14:15 » For if because of food your brother is hurt, you are no longer walking according to love. Do not destroy with your food him for whom Christ died.

Romans 15:1 » Now we who are strong ought to bear the weaknesses of those without strength and not just please ourselves.
