ISAIAH 53

Zechariah 12:10-11 I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn. ¹¹ In that day there will be great mourning in Jerusalem.

Revelation 1:7 Behold, He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him; and all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him. So it is to be. Amen.

1. _____ v1-3

Isaiah 6:9-10 Go, and tell this people: 'Keep on listening, but do not perceive; keep on looking, but do not understand.'

¹⁰ Render the hearts of this people insensitive, their ears dull, and their eyes dim, otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and return and be healed.

John 1:41 Nathanael said to him, "Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?"

John 8:41 They said to [Jesus], "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father: God."

John 7:48 No one of the rulers or Pharisees has believed in Him, has he?

John 6:66 As a result of this many of His disciples withdrew and were not walking with Him anymore.

John 7:5 For not even His brothers were believing in Him.

Mark 6:3 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? Are not His sisters here with us?" And they took offense at Him... And He wondered at their unbelief.

John 12:37-39 But though He had performed so many signs before them, yet they were not believing in Him. ³⁸ This was to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet which he spoke: "Lord, who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?"

Psalms 22:6 But I am a worm and not a man, a reproach of men and despised by the people.

John 1:11 He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him.

2. _____ v4-6

Isaiah 50:6 I gave My back to those who strike Me, and My cheeks to those who pluck out the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting.

Isaiah 52:14 Just as many were astonished at you, My people, so His appearance was marred more than any man and His form more than the sons of men.

Matthew 26:67 Then they spat in His face and beat Him with their fists; and others slapped Him.

Psalms 22:16 For dogs have surrounded me; a band of evildoers has encompassed me; they pierced my hands and my feet.

John 19:34 But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

1 Peter 2:24 and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures.

Micah 6:6-7 With what shall I come to the Lord and bow myself before the God on high? Shall I come to Him with burnt offerings, with yearling calves? ⁷ Does the Lord take delight in thousands of rams, In ten thousand rivers of oil? Shall I present my firstborn for my rebellious acts, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?

Proverbs 14:12 There is a way which seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death.

Psalms 130:3 If You, Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand?

3. _____ v7-9

Luke 9:51 When the days were approaching for His ascension, He was determined to go to Jerusalem.

Matthew 26:39 [He] fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."

Matthew 26:62-63a The high priest stood up and said to Him, "Do You not answer? What is it that these men are testifying against You?" ⁶³ But Jesus kept silent.

Matthew 27:12 And while He was being accused by the chief priests and elders, He did not answer.

Matthew 27:14 And He did not answer [Pilate] with regard to even a single charge, so the governor was quite amazed.

Luke 23:9 And [Herod] questioned Him at some length; but He answered him nothing.

1 Peter 2:22-23 [He] committed no sin, nor was any deceit found in His mouth; ²³ and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously.

John 1:29 The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

4. _____ v10-12

John 17:4 I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do.

2 Corinthians 5:21 He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit.

Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 2:8-11 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. ⁹ For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Revelation 5:12-13 Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing. ¹³ And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them, I heard saying, "To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever."

2 Corinthians 5:14-15 For the love of Christ controls us, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died;

¹⁵ and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.
